John:

First of all, let me know if you get this.

Second, Chemcon wants to construct and operate a process to treat acidic wastewaters contaminated with metal and organic constituents. The process will consist of a tank storage system to store non-treated and treated wastewaters, a neutralization system to adjust the pH, a filter press to remove precipitated solids and an air stripper to remove organic contaminants from wastewaters.

Other than the possible need for air permits, do you see any reason why they should not be allowed to do this. Will I need to write into the permit something about meeting treatment standards or testing and disposal of the sludge from the filter press (metals)?

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
