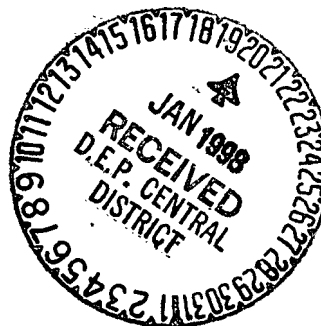


Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

On October 29, 1997, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued a CERCLA Off-site Rule Unacceptability Notice to Chemical Conservation Corporation, Inc. (CCC), Orlando, Florida, EPA ID Number FLD 980 559 728, based on violations of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). Specifically, EPA issued the unacceptable notice for releases of hazardous waste from bulking operations. In the notice, EPA described this violation as one which cannot be undone. The effective date of the notice was December 28, 1997, sixty (60) calendar days from the issuance of the notice. In order to regain acceptable status, EPA requires the payment of penalties for the release violation in accordance with the CERCLA Off-site Rule 300.440(f)(2).

On December 30, 1997, Consent Order OGC number 97-1880 was executed between the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and CCC, which resolved all outstanding violations at the CCC facility. The Consent Order addresses the relevant violations and other violations of RCRA. Pursuant to the Consent Order, CCC agreed to pay \$23,200, for these violations by January 15, 1998. As part of the Consent Order, CCC issued a check for \$23,200 to FDEP on January 6, 1998. Therefore, EPA has determined that the relevant issue in the October 29, 1997, letter has been resolved and CCC is acceptable to receive CERCLA off-site waste. Should any new information affecting this determination develop, EPA reserves its right to revisit this decision.
