Introduction:

The Veolia Transfer Yard (Veolia) is used for the storage of facility transport trailers and is a registered Universal Waste Transfer Area.

Process Description:

At the time of the inspection a total of 17 trailers were present in the yard. Of these, 10 were empty. Of the 7 remaining, 2 contained E-waste that was outbound for Tampa and 5 contained inbound materials to be processed at the Veolia ES Technical Solutions LLC (FL0000207449) site. The storage times vary depending on the content of the trailers. Trailers that have universal waste stored on them are kept in the transfer yard for a maximum of ten days. On the tenth day, or previous to that day, the universal waste is off-loaded at the main facility's docking area for processing. This 10 day storage is tracked by the facility utilizing an Excel spreadsheet, and was reviewed as part of this inspection.
