Here is an update on the Safety-Kleen branch facilities in Florida:

- Medley (Miami) – Damage to facility fence/gate due to downed trees, other than that no damage to buildings/structures. Facility has power, but is not currently operating any services due to access issues from trees/debris on roads leading to the branch.
- Boynton Beach – no damage to report, facility power was restored yesterday afternoon and is operating today.
- Sanford – no damage to report, facility has power and began limited operations yesterday.
- Tampa – no damage to report, facility has power and will begin operations today.
- Orange Park – no damage to report, facility has power and is operating today.
- Tallahassee – no damage to report, facility has power and is operating today.

There were no releases at any of the SK facilities listed above due to Irma. If anyone has any questions let me know.
