### Introduction:

On September 21, 2017, Michael Eckoff and John White, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, attempted to conduct an inspection of Cliff Berry, Inc. - Canaveral Facility to ascertain their compliance with permit number 249477-HO-002, which was issued July 26, 2013 and expires February 5, 2018. Paul Meding, Area Manager, stated the inspection could not be conducted at that time due to an emergency off-site job.

An email was sent to William Parkes, Regulatory Affairs Manager for Cliff Berry, Inc., on September 13, 2017 informing him of the upcoming inspection on September 21, 2017.

An attempt was made to inspect Cliff Berry, Inc. - Canaveral Facility as a used oil processing facility. The facility was not in compliance at that time due to denial of access.
