I have reviewed 40CFR 270.42 as adopted in Rule 17-730.290 and it appears that the type of modifications needed in order to allow operation under the construction permit are Class I modifications. The modifications do not substantially alter the facility or its operation nor are they necessary in order to respond to variations or changes in technology regulations or wastes. See 40 CFR 264.42(d)(ii) and (iii). Rather the changes needed in order to address operational requirements "do not substantially alter the permit conditions or reduce the capacity of the facility to protect human health or the environment." See 40 CFR 264.42(d)(i).

Therefore, pursuant to 40 CFR 264.42(d), Universal hereby requests that the Department make a determination as to the approprate classification for the necessary construction permit modifications.
