

Dear Mr. McKee:

The purpose of this letter is to document the results of a July 14, 1992 inspection conducted by yourself and Mr. Tim Gray. Messrs. Jack Krivec, Jorge Carvajal, and myself from Safety-Kleen assisted during the inspection.

As stated during the inspection, the facility meets the requirements of 40 CFR 264. Pursuant to Specific Condition 8.(d) of permit HC13-175466 and as per Section 17-730250(3), F.A.C., all the requirements of Specific Conditions 8.(a), and 8.(b), and 8.(c) have been satisfied and therefore, the facility may commence hazardous waste storage. We plan to start placing wastes at the facility, in the designated areas on July 16, 1992.

Our operating permit application for the Medley facility should be received by your office on July 17, 1992, which satisfies Specific Condition 9. of the construction permit.
