Dear Mr. Kastury:

Per my telephone conversation with Mr. Michael Hatcher on September 20, the purpose of this letter is to notify the Department of Safety-Kleen's decision to also utilize our new Premium Solvent in Safety-Kleen's new green machine.

Prior to this decision, we notified your office and all six district offices that our Actrel solvent would be used in Safety-Kleen's new green machine and that Premium Solvent would be used in Safety-Kleen's red machines. This means consequently that the spent Actrel would be transported in green drums and the spent Premium Solvent would be transported in red drums to each of our Safety-Kleen storage facilities in Florida.

The hazardous waste permits for our seven active facilities in Florida no longer have color restrictions regarding which color drums we are restricted from receiving; therefore, Safety-Kleen feels that no permit modifications are required for this change. Per our previous permit modification submittals, spent Premium Solvent is transported from the generator in accordance with the generator's hazardous waste determination pursuant to 40 CFR 262.11, and spent Actrel is transported in most cases from the generator as a hazardous waste. Spent Actrel may also be transported as non-hazardous if the generator's determination shows it is non-hazardous.

Furthermore, the cartridge filters used with our red machines are transported from the generator as a hazardous waste in containers and managed at our Florida facilities as a transfer waste. The cyclonic filters used with our green machines are transported with the spent solvent inside the green drum. These filters are then placed in our satellite accumulation drum located next to each facility's wet dumpster.

Per my discussions with Mr. Hatcher, Ed O'Connell of NWFDEP, Stanley Tam of NEFDEP,

Lynn Milanian of SWFDEP, Mary McGehee of CFFDEP, Ghaus Minhaj of SFFDEP, and Knox McKee of SEFDEP, a permit modification is not required for this change but that this written notification should be submitted to the Department.

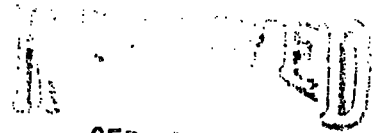
