

## Part II.S Requirements for Equipment

### S. Requirements for Equipment

Subpart BB regulations apply to equipment that contains or contacts hazardous wastes with organic concentrations of at least 10% by weight. The only process that could fall under this requirement would be the consolidation process where portable pump(s) and flexible hoses may be utilized. However, such equipment is not likely to be used for 300 hours or more per calendar year. As provided in 40 CFR 264.1050(f), equipment that contains or contacts hazardous waste with an organic concentration of at least 10% by weight for less than 300 hours is exempt from all requirements of 264.1052 through 264.1060 if such equipment is identified as required in 264.1064(g)(6). Equipment to be identified is the portable pumps and hoses (including any connections and valves) used in the consolidation process for consolidating pumpable liquids from smaller containers to larger containers for hazardous wastes with organic concentrations of at least 10% by weight.

Thus, Subpart BB requirements do not apply to Triumvirate Environmental Services, Inc. other than identifying equipment per 264.1064(g)(6), which is addressed in the paragraph above.
