The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), Northeast District Office of Emergency Response (OER), has reviewed the *Emergency Source Removal Report* received on January 31, 2017, for the above-referenced incident, in accordance with rule 62-780.500, Florida Administrative Code (Fla. Admin. Code). Based upon the information received, the Report indicates that further work is needed. Contamination remains at the referenced location and must be further assessed and remediated pursuant to Chapter 62-780, Fla. Admin. Code.

The Northeast District Office of Emergency Response is hereby **referring the case** for additional action. Within the next 30 days or so, you will be notified of additional actions that will be required, regarding the cleanup or monitoring of the contaminated site. All further documents, forms, reports, etc. should be sent directly to the DEP Division of Waste Management in Tallahassee. In the meantime, we recommend that you continue cleanup actions in accordance with Chapter 62-780, Fla. Admin. Code to minimize the migration of contamination.
