Dear Mr. Davis,

On June 5, 2018, the City of Jacksonville's Environmental Quality Division's Hazardous Waste Program conducted a Hazardous Waste Verification Inspection at your facility, **USEPA ID# FLD984209346**. As a result of the inspection, it has been determined that your facility was operating as a **Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator**, generating no more than 20 kilograms of hazardous waste per month.

The following areas of concern were identified during this inspection:

- 1) A mobile drum used for collecting used oil was not labeled properly with the words "Used Oil."
- 2) A drum containing used oil was not labeled properly with the words "Used Oil".
- 3) Waste antifreeze was being accumulated pending proper disposal. Please note that after disposal, waste management records documenting proper disposal should be kept on file for a minimum of three years.
- 4) Paint waste was being accumulated pending proper disposal. Please note that after disposal, waste management records documenting proper disposal must be kept on file for a minimum of three years.
- 5) A hazardous waste determination must be made on paint booth filters prior to disposal.
- 6) A drum collecting aerosol can solvent waste should be labeled with the words "Hazardous Waste."

The above areas of concern should be addressed as soon as possible to ensure that your facility is in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local regulations.
