Re: Exemption; Used Oil Transporter Training Requirement (Rule 62-710, Florida Administrative Code)

Dear Mr. McClere:

Thank you for your prompt response to the Certified Letter sent to you by this Department on Nov. 13, 1997. This letter mentioned that your certification had not been renewed due to lack of information regarding your Used Oil Transporter activities.

As per our recent phone conversation, Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) may use the certification exemption found in Section 403.767(1)(c), Florida Statutes, provided the Authority is transporting only its own used oil.

If JEA is transporting only its own used oil, generated at their own noncontiguous facilities, to their own central collection facility, it is exempt from the Certification requirement found in Rule 62-710.600, Florida Administrative Code. Please note that if JEA transports used oil from sources other than its own facilities, it must comply with all of the Used Oil Registration and Certification requirements.

Accordingly, JEA may disregard the November 13 letter.
