- B. Certain capitalized words and phrases used herein shall have the meanings as defined herein and if not otherwise defined shall have the same meanings as used in the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- C. Both the Company and Buyer are duly authorized and validly existing companies under the laws of the State of Florida.
- D. As of the Effective Date, the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, amends and restates in its entirety any prior Operating Agreement(s) by and among the Company. CleanPro, LLC., Gama Environmental Consultants, LLC., Ramon Mijares, Luisa Mijares, and Bernardo Mijares will be collectively known as the "Original Members".
- E. Buyer desires to purchase from Company and Company desires to sell to Buyer membership interests in Company representing an undivided 60% Percentage Interest, 60% Economic Interest, and 60% Voting Interest in the Company immediately after giving effect to consummation of this transaction (the "Ownership Interests"), on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein.
- F. Buyer will own an option to purchase an undivided 100% Percentage Interest, 100% Economic Interest, and 100% Voting Interest in the Company any time eighteen (18) months after the Effective Date.

NOW, THEREFORE, as described above, and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration,

4.6 Delays or Omissions

No delay or omission to exercise any right, power, or remedy accruing to any party upon any breach or default of the other party under this Agreement shall impair any such right, power, or remedy of such first party, nor shall it be construed to be a waiver of any such breach or default, or an acquiescence therein, or of or in any similar breach or default thereafter occurring; nor shall any waiver of any single breach or default be deemed a waiver of any other breach or default theretofore or thereafter occurring. Any waiver, permit, consent, or approval of any kind or character on the part of any holder of any breach or default under this Agreement, or any waiver on the part of any holder of any provisions or conditions of this Agreement, must be in writing and shall be effective only to the extent specifically set forth in such writing or as provided in this Agreement.

4.7 Expenses

Company and Buyer shall each bear the expenses and legal fees incurred on their own behalf with respect to this Agreement and the transactions contemplated hereby.

4.8 Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which may be executed by only one party, which shall be enforceable against the parties actually executing such counterparts, and all of which together shall constitute one instrument.

4.9 Severability and Enforcement

In the event that any provision of this Agreement becomes or is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, unenforceable, or void, this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect without such provision; provided that no such severability shall be effective if it materially changes the economic benefit of this Agreement to any party. The parties hereto agree that irreparable damage for which money damages would not be an adequate remedy would occur in the event that any provision of this Agreement were not performed in accordance with its specific terms or was otherwise breached. It is accordingly agreed that, in addition to any other remedies a party may have at law or equity, the parties shall be entitled to seek an injunction or injunctions to prevent such breach of this Agreement and to enforce specifically the terms hereof.

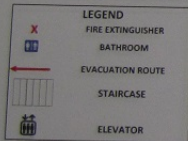

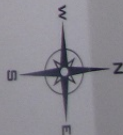

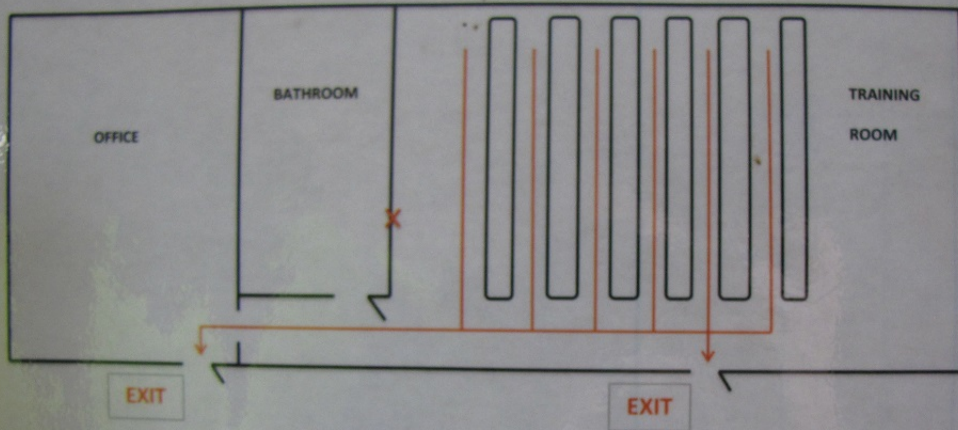

Emergency Action Plan Policy

Scope

Waste Pro USA will take every possible action to comply with all emergency regulations and protect employees in emergency situations.

Purpose

This policy identifies actions necessary in all emergency situations that could cause hazard to life or property from accidental or natural causes. The intent of this policy is to provide guidance to complying with OSHA 29CFR1910.38.

Responsibilities

The OSHA compliance manager shall:

- Ensure regional safety managers (RSMs) are trained in compliance with OSHA 29 CFR1910.38.
- Review and update this policy as needed.
- Aid in the development and revision of site-specific emergency action plans.

The regional safety managers shall:

- Ensure all personnel are trained in accordance with this policy and the company emergency action plan training program.
- Ensure site-specific emergency action plans are developed.
- Update specific information (e.g. names, resources, etc.) to site-specific emergency action plans, when needed.
- Establish whether there are special needs for the evacuation of site personnel (e.g. stair chairs, wheelchair assistance, etc.)
- Establish a primary and secondary "floor warden" at each site for emergency action plans.
- Train floor wardens on their individual responsibilities under the site emergency action plan.

The site manager or supervisor shall:

- Ensure all personnel are scheduled for corporate and site-specific emergency action plan training.
- Ensure all items needed for emergency action plans are available for use by identified personnel.
- Assist the RSM in identifying primary and secondary floor wardens at each site.
- Support the floor warden's authority in an emergency situation.
- Maintain the responsible personnel list in the emergency action plan and notify the RSM when there is a change of responsible personnel.

Employees shall:

- Comply with this policy and all procedures for emergency action.
- Follow all guidance and directions provided by floor wardens and supervisors during an emergency, as trained.
- Immediately report to supervisors any concerns or questions regarding the emergency action plan at their work site.



- Procedures and list of personnel (if any) who are assigned to operate critical operations before they evacuate. Tasks may include shut down of flammable/combustible cylinders, electrical power, machinery, etc. These employees will require additional training. If no shut-downs are necessary then state this on the plan.
- Employee accountability procedures after an evacuation (after all employees and/or visitors have reported to the designated rally point).

Chain of Command:

A chain of command shall be developed to minimize confusion during an emergency event. Employees should know who is in charge during an emergency. A primary, secondary and contingent coordinator shall be identified. As more qualified personnel arrive at an emergency site, the chain of command may change. All changes will be communicated throughout the chain of command.

Personnel within the chain of command will have the following duties:

- Assess the situation to determine whether an emergency or potential emergency exists.
- Direct the initial efforts in the area (until more qualified personnel arrive at the scene).
- Ensure all outside emergency agencies are notified, when necessary.
- Secure the premises, when necessary (e.g. closing a landfill, transfer station or recycling plant for a chemical leak).

Alarm Systems:

Designate the type of system that will alert all employees of an emergency. This will be different for different emergencies. (For example, in the event of a tornado, you will not pull the fire alarm as that would indicate employees must evacuate the building. Employees should not evacuate the building in severe weather.

Shelter in place:

A shelter in place must be identified in training for emergencies such as, but not limited to, workplace violence or severe weather.

Essential equipment:

In some situations, support equipment may be identified in the site plan for essential functions. These items could include but are not limited to:

- Generators
- Rations (food and water)
- Emergency lighting

Communications:

Communications equipment should be present for notifying employees in the case of an emergency. These communication systems include:

- An intercom system, if available
- Fire alarms
- Portable, C.B. or mobile radio systems
- Cellular phones
- Employee alerting systems (small sites where less than 10 employees are present) can be used
- A bull horn (can be used as a backup system in case of system failure)



Fire Extinguishers

Employees are not expected to use a fire extinguisher or other fire-fighting apparatus. However, in complying with requirements of 29CFR1910.157, training will be provided for use of fire extinguishers supplied in the workplace, as well as fire prevention methods annually.

Accountability Procedures

Each floor warden is responsible for accounting for employees and visitors following an emergency evacuation. The following applies to this requirement:

- Rally points are established and identified on the posted evacuation plan.
- All employees and visitors must report to their designated rally point upon notification of evacuation.
- Visitors are the responsibility of the personnel they are visiting.
- Floor wardens will have a list of employees and will obtain this as they evacuate the facility.
- The floor warden will take attendance at the designated rally point to ensure all personnel have been evacuated and confirm whether visitors were inside the building.
- Any persons not accounted for must be immediately reported to an incident commander (e.g. fire fighter) or the highest-ranking Waste Pro USA management personnel at the site.
- The incident commander at the scene will determine the best method for searching for missing persons.

Rescue and medical duties

Rescue efforts shall be conducted by professionals trained and equipped to handle the tasks. Unqualified rescuers sometimes fall victim when not equipped and trained to perform such tasks. Employees assigned to carry out such duties as first aid will do so in accordance with their training and qualifications. These duties must be left to professionals (e.g. fire fighters, EMS personnel, police, etc.). If medical facilities are not in proximity, sites should ensure that a primary, secondary and a contingent first responder is trained to render first aid (as defined by OSHA 1910.151). This training should be provided by an accredited agency such as American Red Cross or the American Herat Association. This should be duplicated for multiple shift operations and lines of business.

Where the eyes or body of any person may be exposed to injurious corrosive materials, suitable facilities for quick drenching or flushing of the eyes and body shall be provided within the work area for immediate emergency use.
[1910.151(c)]

Employee training

Comprehensive training shall include all possible emergency scenarios and necessary procedures. Training shall be provided to all new employees and on an annual basis. Additionally, training shall be provided for employees who are transferred to different sites. Additional training may be needed if sites are redesigned and processes, equipment or chemicals are changed or added. At a minimum, the following will be included in employee training:

- The site evacuation plan, including rally points.
- Types of alarm or alerting systems that will be used.
- Reporting procedures for all personnel.
- Identification and location of floor wardens.
- Shutdown procedures for machinery or equipment and the additional safety measures for employees assigned these duties.
