The Department has reviewed the referenced document that presents sampling results from the January 16 and August 10, 2018 sampling events.

The groundwater quality analysis reported that Benzene and TPH concentrations have remained below GCTLs in all wells for the past two annual monitoring periods consecutively. Cumene was reported above the GCTL but below the NADC in all wells during the January 2018 sampling event and in MW-1 and MW-3 in the August 2018 sampling event.

The overall trends for MW-1, MW-2 and MW-3 shows that Benzene has consistently reported below the Practical Quantitative Limits (PQL) for multiple sampling events. TPH has remained below Groundwater Cleanup Target Levels (GWCTLs) for the majority of the groundwater monitoring history at the site. Cumene concentrations in MW-1 and MW-3, exceed the Groundwater Cleanup Target Levels but have shown an overall downward trend since implementation of NAM at the site, Consent Order dated June 06, 2013.

This report satisfies the January 2015 to December 2018 reporting requirement of the approved NAM. Please inform or notify DEP district office about the next biannual monitoring sample event and copy to Tallahassee.
