The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 or Agency Clerk@dep.state.flus. Petitions filed by the permit applicant and any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this Intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled m written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice of intent or receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition (or a request for mediation, as discussed below) within this time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address,

and the county in which the project proposed; (b) A statement of he when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or propose action; (c) A statement of how petitioner's substantial interests are af fected by the Department's action o proposed action; (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitiones or a statement that there are no dis puted facts; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant re versal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes the petitioner contends require rever sal or modification of the Department action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

A petition that does not sispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, FA.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with

the requirements set forth above.
