Dear Mr. Green:

On January 26, 2021, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") was notified by Broward County North Regional Utilities Department that Southern Underground Industries, Inc., was involved in an unpermitted sanitary sewer overflow(s) ("SSO") of approximately 43,500 gallons in potential violation of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes ("Fla. Stat."), and Rules 62-620 and 62-604, Florida Administrative Code, which prohibit unauthorized discharges.

The District office is in need of further information regarding the above referenced SSO. Your written or emailed response shall be directed to Zara Mansoor via email at Zara.Mansoor@FloridaDEP.gov within **15 days** of receipt of this Warning Letter and shall include the following information:

- Provide the most current information regarding the specific SSO incident stated above, including:
 - Description of what happened to cause the SSO
 - Description of the actions taken to remediate the SSO
 - Description of the actions taken, or to be taken, to prevent future SSOs of this nature.

Upon receipt and review of the above listed information, a meeting or teleconference may be required.
