SUBJECT: Notification of Universal Waste Storage Area (SWMU #16) Relocation

US Ecology, Inc. (USE) is notifying the Department of their intention to relocate the existing universal waste storage area, solid waste management unit (SWMU) number 16, at the USE Tampa facility. Specifically, USE proposes to move this SWMU across the parking lot from its existing location to the concrete paved area on the opposite side of the property as indicated on the attached site plan. This SWMU will still be located within the fenced and secured perimeter of the Orient Road property and there is no proposed increase in the storage capacity within this SWMU.

As you are aware, universal waste material is stored in a box van with a storage capacity of 1,104 cubic feet. USE proposes to simply move the box van to the other side of the Orient Road property as indicated on the attached site plan to facilitate an increase in the volume of universal waste the facility has been receiving. The proposed relocation area will allow for the more efficient and safe handling of this waste stream without the need to transit the Orient Road property across traffic to access the current location of this SWMU. The relocation of SWMU number 16 will be captured in the permit modification to be submitted to the Department in the coming month.

Additionally, USE is considering replacing the existing municipal waste dumpster, SWMU number 5, with a self-contained compactor unit that will require a larger footprint. This will necessitate the relocation of SWMU number 16 as discussed herein.
