An inspection was conducted at Florida Transformer, LLC (DBA Emerald Transformer) on February 24, 2021 jointly with the US Environmental Protection Agency. During this inspection, potential non-compliance was noted. The purpose of this letter is to offer compliance assistance as a means of resolving these matters.

Specifically, potential non-compliance with the requirements of chapter 403, Florida Statutes, chapter 62-710, Florida Administrative Code, and Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 262 and 279 were observed.
