
According to Mr. Mike Cobb, Director of Safety, no hazardous waste is brought to the facility, nor is hazardous waste generated or stored at the facility. Fleet maintenance services are performed by an off-site contractor.


Spent mercury-containing lamps have been transported occasionally in the past to customers that are mercury recovery facilities, such as Mercury Recovery Services, Inc. of Pomono, California or Mercury Technologies, Inc. located in Tampa, Florida. The spent mercury lamps are transported under a bill of lading, in accordance with Florida Administrative Code (FAC) 62-737. According to Mr. Cobb, the facility at this location does not transport any waste materials at this time that would require a hazardous waste manifest.

Landstar Ranger, Inc. notified the Department as a Transporter of hazardous waste on July 14, 2000. The facility is currently a Non-Handler of hazardous waste. Although they do not currently transport hazardous waste, the facility wishes to retain its status as a hazardous waste Transporter. To maintain the Transporter status, the facility annually verifies financial responsibility with the Department, pursuant to Chapter 62-730.170(3), Florida Administrative Code (FAC).

No violations of applicable regulations were observed at the time of inspection in the areas observed.
