- 2. <u>Appendix I-D Facility Description.</u>
 - a. I-D-1.2.4, Page 3 of 24: Please correct any incorrect references on this page. For example, "Section I-C-1.7" and "I-C-1.8.1" should read "Section I-D-1.7 and I-D-1.8.1".
 - b. I-D-1.8.1, Page 7 of 24: Please correct the reference to "Facility Site Plan" to "See Part I, Appendix I-A".
- 3. <u>DEP Form 62-730.900(2)(d)</u>, Part I.
 - a. Page 1 of 4: Include corporation papers detailing corporate compliance and health & safety policies for Clean Harbors, Inc., and provide a list of approved signers/corporate officers for Clean Harbors, LLC, e.g., a letter of authorization.
 - b. Page 2 of 4: The Department is aware that Bartow Executive Airport's (formerly known as "Bartow Municipal Airport") new policy is to have all paperwork brought before the Board prior to signing, and that the Board Meeting for June 2021 will be held on Monday, June 14, 2021. Please send in the necessary signed forms with signatures from the current landowner or representative, and also include a letter of authorization for the signer.
- 4. <u>Table A-19</u>.
 - a. The Facility's permit/license from the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) for transporting waste pharmaceuticals has an expiration date of 3/31/3023. Please edit the date accordingly.
