Mr. Perrigan,

Please find attached to this email the signed letter request to regain our ability to consolidate very small quantities of hazardous waste. In the past we were a DEA contractor tasked with breaking down clandestine meth labs and we would do a small amount of consolidation especially as it pertains to coleman camp fuel, and lighter fluid because the containers were large and they were often not completely full. It is not really our intention to function in that exact same way moving forward because we no longer do the meth lab cleanups. With that being said on occasion we do periodically run into some hazardous materials that are part of the cargo in a truck crash and it is our responsibility to properly categorize, containerize, label, manifest and transport the waste to the office because it is a public safety issue to leave hazardous wastes on the side of the hwy. While on the side of the interstate it is not a safe environment to manage consolidation so we would place all of the damaged containers and saturated packaging into drums then transport them to the shop. The next day in a controlled environment we would like to have the continued permission to segregate & consolidate these like wastes to separate the solids from the liquids and place into separate containers to save on the total number of containers going into the waste stream. Another form of this activity that may be considered consolidation might be collecting vehicle batteries over time on a pallet until we have several to take to recycling center every few weeks. This letter was mailed to you via USPS as well, but I wanted to email you directly so that we may correspond back in forth if you had any questions. I appreciate your consideration Mr. Perrigan.
