Introduction:

On February 9, 2022, Michael Eckoff, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP or Department), inspected M & D Industrial Services, LLC (M & D or Facility) for compliance with state and federal hazardous waste transportation regulations. No one was onsite at the time of the inspection. The facility most recently notified the Department of its waste activities on March 15, 2021 and was originally issued EPA identification number FLR000233148 on November 19, 2019. The facility is currently registered as a used oil and used oil filter transporter (expires 6/30/2022), universal waste lamps and devices transporter (expires 3/1/2022), and hazardous waste transporter (expires 6/30/2022).

Hazardous waste transporter liability insurance expired on February 5, 2022.

NOTE: On February 16, 2022, Mr. Victor San Agustin emailed stating they are working on securing newer certifications.

NOTE: On or about February 28, 2022 the facility provided current liability insurance information indicating the policy effective date of 2/5/2022 and expiration on 2/5/2023.

This is the initial inspection of this facility by the Department for compliance with state and federal hazardous waste transportation regulations.

Process Description:

M & D Industrial Services LLC Inspection Report

Inspection Date: 02/09/2022

Upon arrival at the site the inspector telephoned Mr. San Agustin to obtain access to the site. A voicemail was left for Mr. San Agustin. A number of totes and drums were noted at the site. The inspector waited at the site for approximately 15 minutes prior to leaving the site.

NOTE: On February 16, 2022, Mr. San Agustin emailed stating the totes are empty, five drums contain clean sand/gravel, one drum contains kitty litter and hydraulic oil contaminated soil, and the rest of the drums are empty. Mr. San Agustin also stated that wastes are not stored at the facility.

On February 10, 2022 an email was sent to Mr. San Agustin requesting a copy of hazardous waste manifests for wastes the facility transported.

NOTE: On February 17, 2022, Mr. San Agustin posted copies of manifests on the Department's file transfer protocol (ftp) site. A review of the manifests did not reveal any issues.

Conclusion:

M & D Industrial Services, LLC was inspected as a hazardous waste transporter and no potential violations were noted at that time.
