Introduction:

On August 23, 2022, Miranda Rothenberger and Gina Laddick, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP or Department) inspected Alpha Omega Training & Compliance Inc (AOTC or facility) located at 1445 Cox Rd, Cocoa, Florida, for compliance with state and federal hazardous waste and used oil regulations. The facility was represented by Kirk Kraus, Manager.

The facility was registered as a used oil and used oil filter transporter, but registration expired on June 30, 2022. The facility was registered as a hazardous waste transporter, but registration expired on June 30, 2022. The current site maintains EPA identification number FLR000099903. The facility has only been at this location since 2021 and is currently preparing for a move to another site.

This is the initial inspection of AOTC at this site for compliance.

Process Description:

AOTC maintains approximately 15 trucks out of this location for transportation activities. They primarily act as an emergency response company. There was one work bay on site for vehicle maintenance that had one 750-gallon double walled tank labelled used oil and one 55-gallon drum labelled used oil filters.

Records

The facility last transported hazardous waste on March 7, 2022. Records were maintained on site and in compliance.

The facility last transported used oil on April 14, 2022. Records were maintained on site and in compliance.
