Good afternoon Tarin,

I apologize for not being present in the meeting yesterday, November 7, 2022.

I am writing this email on behalf of Eric Miranda and Chad Gregory to recap your meeting with them regarding Warning Letter #WL22-0171HW06SED.

We have resubmitted form 8700-12FL – Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity to update our Petroleum Contact Water activities to include both transporter and recovery facility [pg 4 of application]. I have attached a copy of the application sent via USPS certified tracking # 7021 0950 0002 2136 1797.

As discussed, WPC will transport PCW in a WPC truck designated for PCW only and stored in a designated PCW tank. PCW will not be mixed or comingled with any other material not defined as PCW. All outgoing PCW deliveries will be clearly manifested as Petroleum Contact Water. Records for all PCW related activities will be maintained on site for a minimum of three years making sure to include the following:

- a. Name and location of the person shipping the PCW.
- b. Date the PCW was picked up.
- c. Volume of the PCW transported.
- d. Name and location of the person receiving the PCW.
- e. Delivery date of the PCW.
- f. A copy of the shipping paper used for shipment of the PCW.
