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In order to complete review of your application pursuant to Section 403.087(4), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Section 17-711.530, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.R.), please provide the following information below:

1. Please provide the Department with proof of financial responsibility issued in favor of the State of Florida in the amount of such approved estimate for closure of the facility. Proof of financial responsibility may include the following financial instruments: escrow accounts, surety bonds, performance bonds, financial guarantee bonds, irrevocable letters of credit, certificate of deposit, securities and other documents approved by the Department. The financial instruments shall be issued by a surety company or financial institution licensed to do business in the state of Florida (17-711.510(2), FAC).
2. Exhibit H of the application provided the estimated cost for closure of this existing "Waste Tire Processing Facility". However, this documentation does not provide for the costs to remove unprocessed tires that could accumulate of upwards to thirty times greater than the daily through put of 50 tons/day (17-711.530(2), FAC). Therefore please revise the estimated costs of closure to include this figure pursuant to 17-711.700(2)(d), FAC.
