6. Fire Fighting Equipment and Training:

a. During the month, FTR continued its practice of starting and running each of the fire trucks in its fire battalion and generally checking the condition of the fire equipment.

6. Trust Fund:

a. A \$4,000 deposit was made the Trust Fund established for financial assurance on January 13, 1996. As of February 29, 1996 the balance was approximately \$142,227 including interest.

7. Engineering and Permit Applications:

a. As previously reported, permits are now in hand to commenced construction of the MSSW system. A copy of the storm water management permit from St. Lucie County dated March 18, 1996 is attached for reference.

8. Other:

a. A copy of the invoice and security agreement are attached evidencing FTR's purchase of a Caterpillar model 225 Hydraulic Excavator and Pemberton Model S39000 Tire Shear. The excavator will be used to start construction of the MSSW system. The shear will facilitate recycling of the off-the-road tires on site.

b. FTR continues to await final approval of funding for full installation of the MSSW system.

c. FTR began shipping TDF to a new account conducting test burns for a air quality permit modification to utilize this alternate fuel. If successful, this would be the first conventional TDF account permitted in the state of Florida. The company has experienced mechanical feeder problems and has suspended testing until they are resolved. This resulted in a shortfall in FTR's monthly inventory reduction target.

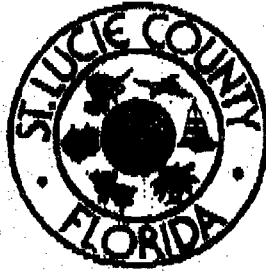

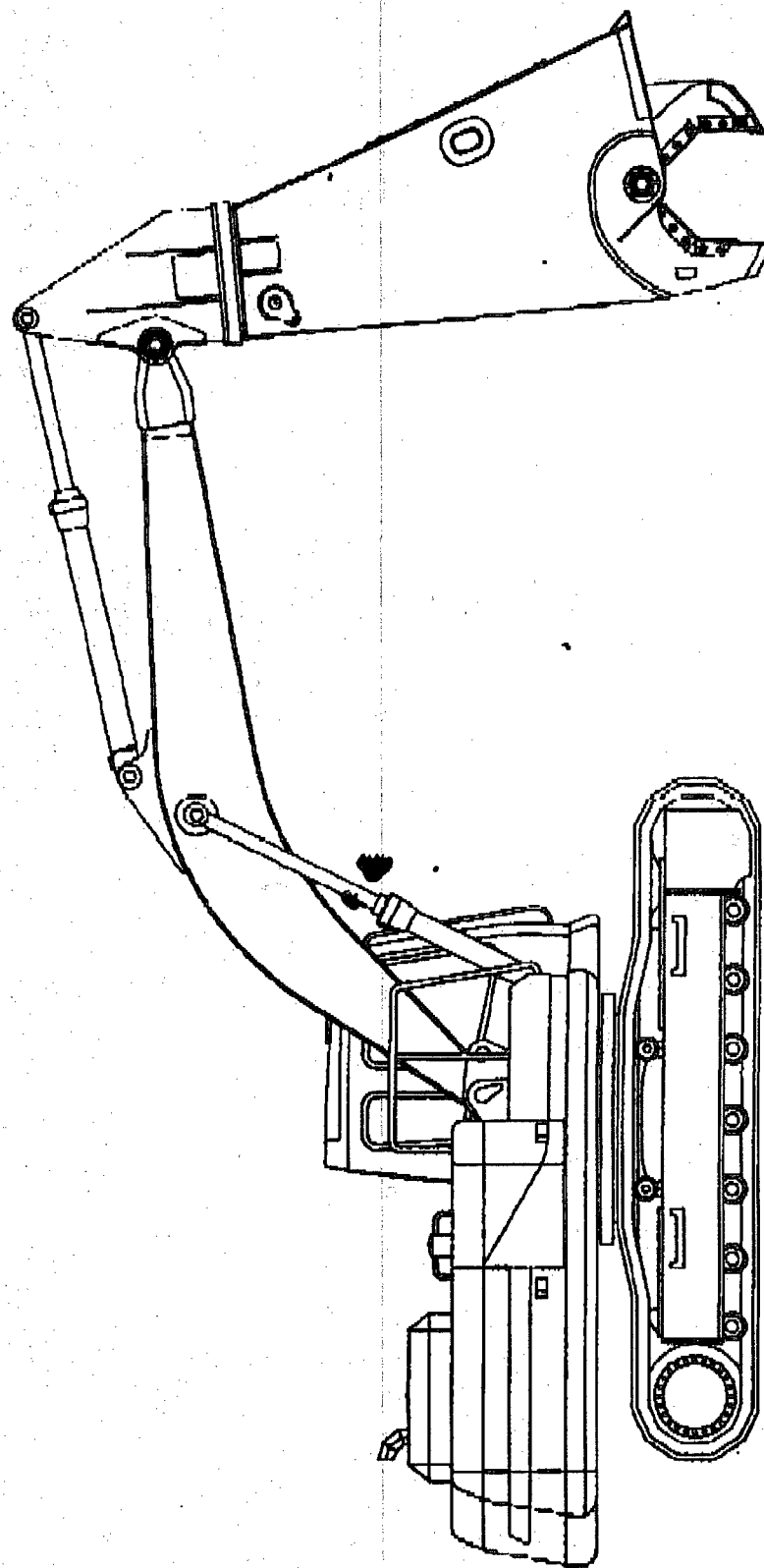
