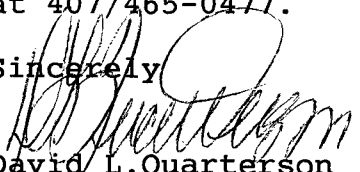

Work has been completed collecting and stacking all whole tires from the interim storage area and cleaning shreds from the fire lanes as discussed in the meeting between FTR and FDEP on May 15, 1995.

5. Fire Fighting Equipment and Training:

a. During the month, FTR continued its practice of starting and running each of the fire trucks in its fire

battalion and generally checking the condition of the fire equipment.

6. Trust Fund:

a. A \$4,000 deposit was made the Trust Fund established for financial assurance on June 13, 1994. As of June 30, 1995 the balance was \$112,816.90.

7. Engineering and Permit Applications:

a. FTR delivered its application for an amended MSSW permit to FDEP on June 2, 1995. The permit modification was received on July 21, 1995.

b. FTR received a request for additional information from St. Lucie county regarding the ammended site plan and is in the process of compiling a response.
