

5. Fire Fighting Equipment and Training:

a. During the month, FTR continued its practice of starting and running each of the fire trucks in its

fire battalion and generally checking the condition of the fire equipment.

b. A refresher course for FTR's certified fire brigade has been scheduled with instructors from Indian River Community College.

6. Trust Fund:

a. A \$4,000 deposit was made the Trust Fund established for financial assurance on May 13, 1994. As of May 31, 1995 the balance was slightly in excess of \$106,000.00.

7. Engineering and Permit Applications:

a. FTR delivered its application for an amended MSSW permit to FDEP on June 2, 1995.

b. An amended site plan has been delivered to St. Lucie county.
