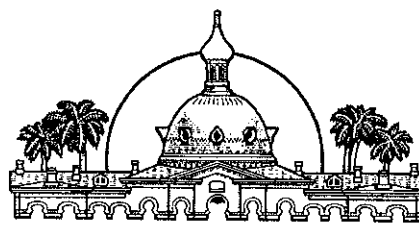

The 2011 closure and long-term care cost estimate updates for the Southeast County Landfill (SCLF) Phases I-VI and Sections 7, 8, and 9 are enclosed, fulfilling the requirements of Rule 62-701.630 (4) and Specific Condition D.4.a of the SCLF operations permit. The cost estimate updates are inflation adjustments utilizing the current rate of 1.010.

The 2011 cost estimate forms for Phases I through VI and Sections 7 through 9 are being submitted separately. The Public Utilities Department, Solid Waste Management Division (SWMD) intends to continue to submit these cost estimates on separate forms. This allows the SWMD to more efficiently update quantities for the Capacity Expansion Area and Phases I-VI as well as distinguish the fiscal responsibility for each area.

III. ESTIMATE ADJUSTMENT

☒ (a) Inflation Factor Adjustment



Inflation adjustment using an inflation factor may only be made when a Department approved closure cost estimate exists and no changes have occurred in the facility operation which would necessitate modification to the closure plan. The inflation factor is derived from the most recent Implicit Price Deflator for Gross National Product published by the U.S. Department of Commerce in its survey of Current Business. The inflation factor is the result of dividing the latest published annual Deflator by the Deflator for the previous year. The inflation factor may also be obtained from the Solid Waste website www.dep.state.fl.us/waste/categories/swfr or call the Financial Coordinator at (850) 245-8706.
