

b. During December, FTR's primary TDF account shut down the boiler using TDF for extensive

maintenance. As of the date of this report, the boiler has not gone back on line.

5. Fire Fighting Equipment and Training:

a. During the month, FTR continued its practice of starting and running each of the fire trucks in its fire battalion and generally "checking" the condition of the fire equipment.

6. Trust Fund:

a. A \$4,000 deposit was made the Trust Fund established for financial assurance on December 10, 1994. As of November 30, 1994 the balance was \$85,875 plus accrued interest.

7. Engineering and Permit Applications:

a. FTR and/or its attorney wrote the DEP on October 24, November 23 and again on December 9, 1994 regarding timing of the MSSW construction and the linkage between the MSSW construction, the financial assurance requirements and issuance of the operating permit. FTR continues to await reply from FDEP and has been unable to comply with Item 4 of the Limiting Conditions of MSSW Permit Number MS 56-2451186 as a result.
