Dear Mr. Kahn,

As we compile the information that you recently requested on behalf of the Department's legal staff, I am writing to remind you of our need to receive as soon as possible answers to or information regarding the following:

1. The DEP's suggested time line for stabilization and financial security.

2. The DEP's recommended fire prevention requirements and safety thresholds for: (a) The period during which stabilization is achieved; (b) the period following in which full compliance is in place.

3. An answer to our question regarding the confidentiality of materials we are providing in this process and specifically, protection of our financial information from potential competitors.

As I have expressed during our two meetings and several telephone conversations, it will be impossible for FLORIDA TIRE RECYCLING, INC. to present a plan that addresses the Department's concerns if we are not made aware of those concerns. While we accept the responsibility of authoring a compromise solution, we must know the goals of our partners to the solution.
