RE: PLAN TO ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE

Dear Mr. Kahn.

As we compile the information that you recently requested on behalf of the Department's legal staff, I am writing to remind you of our need to receive as soon as possible answers to or information regarding the following:

- 1. The DEP's suggested time line for stabilization and financial security.
- 2. The DRP's recommended fire prevention requirements and safety thresholds for: (a) The period during which stabilization is achieved; (b) the period following in which full compliance is in place.
- 3. An answer to our question regarding the confidentiality of materials we are providing in this process and specifically, protection of our financial information from potential competitors.
- As I have expressed during our two meetings and several telephone conversations, it will be impossible for FLORIDA TIRE RECYCLING, INC. to present a plan that addresses the Department's concerns if we are not made aware of those concerns. While we accept the responsibility of authoring a compromise solution, we must know the goals of our partners to the solution.

It is my hope that you will have answers to and/or information regarding these questions and issues when we meet on Friday.

Finally, have confirmed our meeting on Friday with Chief Vaughn.
