Dear Mr. Lurix,

At your suggestion and following our telephone conversation of Wednesday evening, I am writing to explain our new hours of operation and the affect these will have on the Class D security which we have hired to patrol the site.

As I explained, in order to produce fuel quality material for use at Cedar Springs, GA we are now operating 3 processing shifts Monday through Saturday at 4:00 p.m. On Sunday we operate one processing shift from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

While we process every day, we continue to receive material only on 5 business days, Monday through Friday.

Therefore, in order to provide site security as described in the Stipulation C.2. (a) we have retained the services of AMERICAN SECURITIES ASSOCIATES OF FLORIDA to provide a Class D security person from 4:00 Saturday afternoon to 6:00 a.m. Sunday morning and again from 4:00 Sunday afternoon until 6:00 a.m. Monday.


