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#### 6. Fire Fighting Equipment and Training:

a. During the month, FTR continued its practice of starting and running each of the fire trucks in its fire battalion and generally checking the condition of the fire equipment.

#### 6. Trust Fund:

a. A \$4,000 deposit was made the Trust Fund established for financial assurance on April 13, 1996. As of April 29, 1996 the balance was \$157,317.00 including interest.

#### 7. Engineering and Permit Applications:

a. During the month of April, FTR commenced construction of the MSSW system despite still not receiving approval for funding of the project. The wet detention area and wetlands areas have been surveyed and staked. The perimeter road from Range Line Road to the wet detention area has been graded and improved to permit access to the working area. And the excavation of the key ditch has been completed. A copy of FTR's notification to the South Florida Water Management District is attached for reference.

#### 8. Other:

a. At the beginning of April, FTR experienced a massive failure to the bearings of the main shaft of one of its two TDF processors severely reducing production during the period. Repair to the unit was not completed until the first week of May. This in turn caused a reduction of outbound shipments of about 1,500 tons.
