Dear Sir,

Pursuant to our phone discussion this morning, I am writing to memorialize the changes agreed to in the draft stipulation agreement faxed by Janet Bowman to Jim Brindell on August 14, 1995. They included:

1. Paragraph 8.A.(2) shall be amended as indicated by the underlined sections below:

removal requirements over the three month period from September 1 - November 30, 1995, florida Tire shall, commencing December 1, 1995 and continuing through July 31, 1996, remove at least 1,500 tons of waste tires per month more than the volume of waste tires received at the site during the calendar month. (The base removal amount for December 1, 1995 through July 31, 1996.)

- 2, Section 8.A.(5) shall be amended by the underlined section below:
 - (5) By November 1, 1995 or sixty (60) days after the department issues the MSSW permit, whichever occurs first, Florida Tire shall have initiated construction of the MSSW system as set forth in Permit No. 56-2451186, as modified on July 17, 1995. By March 1, 1996, or within 150 days of issuance of the MSSW permit by the Department, whichever occurs first, Florida Tire shall have completed construction ...

Further, we have agreed to forward to your attention a copy of Florida Tire's applications to St. Lucie County for a county storm water permit and a building permit as they are submitted.

I will advise Jim Brindell of these changes. May I suggest your office ask Janet Bowman to make these changes and forward a final draft to Brindell.

I'd like to close by thanking you for your consideration on these
