Per your specific request, attached are three sets of the following documents related to the Florida Tire Recycling, Inc site:

- (1) A topographical survey initiated by Allen E. Beck Professional Land Surveyors on September 28, 1994 under subcontract to T.A.G. Resource Recovery as you requested.
- (2) A boundary survey conducted by the same surveyor prior to initiation of the above topographical survey.
- (3) An earlier site topographical survey used by Beck to establish ground conditions for volume estimates dispersed across the property.
- (4) The surveyor's letter report defining volumes of waste tires/
  shreds contained on the site based on the above topographical
  survey. Pile volumes were computer-calculated based on
  surveyed pile dimensions from the toe of piles. Ground level
  shred estimates were also computer-generated by comparison of
  current elevations to those in the earlier survey.
- (5) Originals of reports prepared by T.A.G. Resource Recovery defining quantities and dimensional conformance with DEP regulations based on the above boundary and topographical surveys and report.
