Dear Ms. Madden:

The following items are submitted in response to the comment section for the on-site inspection at the Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC) on February 3, 2010:

Reminder – Tank Inspection report due April 15, 2010 (Specific Condition C.8.c.(8.)(c.))

The tank inspection has been scheduled to start on March 1, 2010. The company inspecting the tank is Crom Engineering & Construction Services, Inc.

Reminder – Monitoring Plan Evaluation Report due November 15, 2010, Specific Condition E.11.

The monitoring plan evaluation will be initiated when all sampling data for the monitoring period has been collected and the results confirmed.

Specific Condition C.2.d requires notification (in writing) of a change to the County's primary onsite supervisor within 7 days of the effective start date of the new responsible individual.

Mr. Frank Coggins, who is listed as the current Permittee/Manager for the facility retired on February 12, 2010. A separate letter indicating a change effective that date in the primary onsite supervisor has been included with this response.

Please noted that based on the funding mechanism used by the County for Financial Assurance, revised or inflation-adjusted cost estimated will be due to the Department no later than March 1 each year.

The annual Financial Assurance Cost Estimate for CCSWDC was sent to Susan Pelz on January 25, 2010. The proof of financial assurance using a financial test will be submitted to FDEP by

the Clerk of the Court, Finance section on or before 180 days after the close of the succeeding fiscal year.

2.20-A small area of exposed waste was observed in an outside berm on the E slope. This area was repaired during the inspection.

Correction immediately made by onsite landfill operator.

2.22 – Minor blowing litter was observed S of the working face. Strong winds observed during the inspection.

Litter fence in place and area cleaned of blowing litter on a daily basis.

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SECTION L OPERATIONS PLAN

L.1 TRAINING

In accordance with Rule 62-701.500(1), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), key supervisory staff at the CCSWDC Landfill have received Landfill Operator Certification training. The training plan can be found in Attachment L-1. Sarasota County staff or a qualified landfill operations contractor will operate the facility. Sarasota County will require the operating entity to provide at least one trained landfill operator certified in accordance with Chapter 62-701.32(15), F.A.C. and at least one trained spotter at each working face during operation when the landfill receives waste to detect unauthorized wastes from each load.

The spotters will be responsible for guiding vehicles and promoting an efficient operation during normal operation hours. The spotters shall also be responsible for enforcing provisions for controlling the waste received. These provisions are described in Section L.2.c.

The facility will be operated in compliance with all applicable regulations governing the operation of solid waste management facilities and surface water management facilities.

In addition, the equipment operators have sufficient training and knowledge to move waste and soil, and to develop the site in accordance with the design plans and operational standards.

L.2 LANDFILL OPERATIONS PLAN

L.2.a Designation of Responsible Persons

The Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex (CCSWDC) is owned by Sarasota County and operated under the direction of the Sarasota County Solid Waste Operations Unit. Lois E. Rose, Manager Solid Waste, will be the designated responsible person for the operation of the CCSWDC. A list of the landfill personnel is given below as well as typical training required for each position:
