Dear Mr. Dimonnay:

On behalf of Liberty Tire Recycling, LLC (Liberty Tire), Golder Associates Inc. (Golder) requests a 30-day time extension to submit the Site Assessment Report (SAR) for the Port St. Lucie facility. Additional time and effort were required to establish a scope and cost estimate acceptable to the adjacent property owner and to Liberty Tire's insurance agency. Golder is requesting this time extension in order to conduct additional assessment activities at this facility and to prepare the SAR. In general, these activities will include: a) installation of groundwater monitoring wells in the vicinity of the former shredded tire piles and the adjacent offsite property; b) collection of soil samples in the vicinity of the former shredded tire piles and the adjacent offsite property; c) collection of groundwater level measurements from the wells to confirm groundwater flow direction; d) collection of groundwater samples at the monitoring wells; and e) preparation of the SAR, to be submitted within the above-mentioned time frame.
