On behalf of Waste Management, Inc. of Florida (WM), HSA Golden is providing responses and information addressing your Second Request for Additional Information (dated May 13, 2011) to the Renewal of Operations Permit application for the subject facility. Hereafter, we restate the Department's comments in italics, followed by our responses. Three (3) copies of all requested information are submitted with revisions noted with strikethrough (strikethrough) and shading (shading). All revisions to drawings are summarized in the revision box on each sheet, and clouded if a detail or note has been revised or added.

Comment 2.a The response to Comment #2 of RAIl is not adequate.

As stated in my 3/19/2010 e-mail, "Vista Landfill is not authorized to store or dispose of waste within 500 feet of the potable well at 138 Keene Rd." That prohibition remains in effect until the Department receives proof that the residences affected (138, 146 and 166 West Keene Road) have been connected to a public water system and either the well has been properly abandoned or acknowledgement from the property owner(s) that they will not use the well for potable water.

- Response 2.a Acknowledged, please see response to Comment 2c below.
- Comment 2.b Comment #2 of RAI 1 was written because no proof had been submitted in the original application that the corrective actions had been completed. In the Report, HSA Golden provided a tab ("Response to Comment 2.b) with various documents, including the payment of document fees to the city of Apopka. The



documents do not provide clear proof that the potable well is no longer being used.

- Response2.b Acknowledged, please see response to Comment 2c below.
- Comment 2.c To resolve this issue provide a report that includes documents proving the residences affected (138, 146 and 166 West Keene Road) have been connected to a public water system and either the well has been properly abandoned or acknowledgement from the property owner(s) that they will not use the well for potable water. The report must be signed and sealed by a licensed engineer.
- Response2.c The property owner of all three properties, Bennie Brown, has prepared and signed a letter stating that these residences are connected to the City of Apopka's municipal water supply and that the potable wells located at these properties will no longer be used for personal consumption. This letter, along with a cover letter signed and sealed by a licensed engineer and the previously submitted documents showing that these residences have paid impact fees to the City of Apopka for water connections are provided in Response to Comment 2.c attached.
- Comment 20: Your response to RAI 1 comment 20 was, "The Biennial Report is currently under development by SCS Engineers and will be submitted to the FDEP in the near future." This response is inadequate.
- Comment 20.a The current Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedule (revised 1/4/2008 as part of Permits SC48-0165969-014 and S048-0165969-015) clearly states in Item 23, "a technical report shall be submitted to the Department every two years, and shall be updated at the time of permit renewal. The first report is due 30 days after the submittal of the monitoring data for the fourth ground water sampling event of the two year period."
- Response 20.a Acknowledged, please see response to Comment 20.c below.
- Comment 20.b A background water sampling event was conducted in April 2008. The December 2008 sampling event was the first ground water monitoring after waste was placed starting in November 2008. The fourth ground water sampling event would have been June 2010. Therefore, the first Biennial Report (Technical Report) should have been submitted soon after the submittal of the groundwater quality report for the June 2010 sampling event.
- Response 20.b Acknowledged, please see response to Comment 20.c below
- Comment 20.c The Technical Report must be in the next submittal. As required by MPIS Item 23: The report shall summarize and interpret the water quality data and water level measurements collected during the past four years. The report shall contain, at a minimum, the following:

- a. Tabular and graphical displays of any data that shows that a monitoring parameter has been detected, including hydrographs for all monitoring wells.
- b. Trend analyses of any monitoring parameters detected.
- c. Comparisons among shallow, middle, and deep zone wells.
- d. Comparison between upgradient and down gradient wells.
- e. Correlation between related parameters such as total dissolved solids and specific conductance.
- f. Discussion of erratic and/or poorly correlated data.
- g. An interpretation of the ground water contour maps, including an evaluation of ground water flow rates.
- h. An evaluation of the adequacy of the water quality monitoring frequency and sampling locations based upon site conditions.

This report must be signed and sealed pursuant to Florida Statutes (F.5.) Chapters 471 and 492 which require that documents requiring the practice of professional engineering or professional geology, as described in Chapter 471 or 492, F.5., be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them. This certification must be made by a licensed professional who is able to demonstrate competence in the subject area(s) addressed within the sealed document."

Response 20.c The Technical Report was submitted by SCS Engineers to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Central District on May 18, 2011.

We trust that this submittal will meet the Department's additional information requirements and allow the renewal of the subject operations permit. If you have any questions, please do not he sitate to email or call.

All three (3) of the properties are owned by Bennie Brown. Included as part of this report is acknowledgement that the above referenced properties will not use the existing wells on the properties for any personal consumptive purposes. The letter is dated June 3, 2011, addressed to Ms. Sheree Grant of Waste Management Inc. of Florida, and signed by Bennie Brown.


