Pursuant to Section 403.815, Florida Statutes, and DEP Rule 62-103.150, Florida Administrative Code, you (the applicant) are required to publish at your own expense the enclosed Notice of Application. The notice shall be published one time only within 15 days of the date the application was filed with this Department. The notice shall be published in the legal ad section of a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected. For the purpose of this rule, "publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected" means publication in a newspaper meeting the requirements of Section 50.011 and 50.031, F.S., in the county where the activity is to take place. Where there is more than one newspaper of general circulation in the county, the newspaper used must be one with significant circulation in the area that may be affected by the permit. If you are uncertain that a newspaper meets these requirements, please contact the undersigned at the address or telephone number listed below.

You must provide proof of publication to the Department, at Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resources Management, Waste Regulation Section, 33 SW 2nd Avenue, Suite 800, Miami, Florida 33130, within seven days of publication. Failure to publish the notice and provide proof of publication within the allotted time may result in the denial of the permit.

Dear Mr. Vardeman:

Referenced is made to your application for a permit renewal, file number 0133892-002-SO, received February 27, 2001, and to the Revised Estimate of Resource Recovery Facility Closure Costs, dated March 27, 2001. Said cost estimate covers the possible disposal of 53,440 tons of contaminated and treated soils. Said quantity is based on the 960 ton-quantity processed daily for 55 days. However, based on 62-713.600(5) & (6)(c), F.A.C., you are required to cover long term care, which is associated with the post-closure sampling of monitoring wells for five (5) years.

Therefore, DERM requires an adjustment to the closure cost to cover said long-term care in addition to the costs associated with the disposal of stored contaminated and treated soils. Please itemize and recalculate the closure estimate based on the considerations discussed above. Said documentation must be submitted to this office within fifteen (15) days upon receipt of this letter.
