Dear Mr. Pinkerton:

This letter acknowledges receipt of your additional information in support of pending modifications of permit conditions for the Citrus County Central Landfill.

This letter constitutes notice that a permit modification will be required for your project pursuant to Chapter(s) 403, Florida Statutes.

Your application for permit modification remains <u>incomplete</u>. Please provide the information listed below promptly. Evaluation of your proposed project will be delayed until <u>all</u> requested information has been received.

The following information is needed in support of the solid waste application [Chapter 17-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)]:

- 1. Due to inadequate leachate treatment at the Zimpro PACT plant with chronic difficulties meeting groundwater standards for nitrate, coliform, chlorides and total dissolved solids (TDS), the Department requests the status and/or proposed resolutions of problems at this plant which are intended to be discussed at Citrus County's meetings with the plant manufacturer.
- 2. Information relative to the status of procurement of materials for installation for the culverts, lined swale (stormwater conveyance from Cell 1-A to the stormwater drainage area) and permanent leachate pumping system with control panel at the lined leachate collection pond is requested.
- 3. Provide the Department with the status of hydroseeding of all slopes. Update the "seeding plan" sketch dated February 2, 1993.

4. Provide the Department a status report and/or copy of a letter to the Department of Forestry requesting use of their property for spray irrigation.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 120.600, F.S. and Chapter 17-12.070(5), F.A.C., if the Department does not receive a response to this request for information within 30 days of the date of this letter, the Department may issue a final order denying your application. If the response will require longer than 30 days to develop, you should develop a specific time table for the submission of the requested information for Department review and consideration. Failure to comply with a time table accepted by the Department will be grounds for the Department to issue a Final Order of Denial for lack of timely response. A denial for lack of information or response will be unbiased as to the merits of the application. The applicant can reapply as soon as the requested information is available."
