SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

6. **Special Wastes.** The design, operation, and monitoring of disposal or control of any "special wastes" shall be in accordance with F.A.C. 62-701.300(8), 62-701.520 and any other applicable Department rules, to protect the public safety, health and welfare. "Special Wastes" means solid wastes that can require special handling and management, including but not limited to white goods, waste tires, used oil, lead-acid batteries, construction and demolition debris, asbestos, ash residue, yard trash, and biological wastes.

a. All solid wastes, recovered materials or residues handled at the site shall be managed in a manner so as not to constitute a fire or safety hazard or a sanitary nuisance, and shall comply with all applicable local or state regulations. Recovered resources which may be offered for sale shall comply with applicable regulations of all appropriate state agencies.

b. White goods and scrap metals that are held for the purposes of recycling shall be held no longer than one hundred and eighty (180) days, and shall be stored in a manner so as to prevent the discharge of CFCs and other residuals which may cause air or groundwater pollution. White goods containing CFCs (freon) shall be stored in an upright position.

c. Yard trash accepted at the site shall be processed and recycled, or disposed of within twelve months. Recycling Yard Trash: Best Management Practices Manual for Florida shall be used as guidance. Amended April 28, 1999

7. **Landfill Operation Requirements.** The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with F.A.C. 62-701.500, Landfill Operation Requirements, and Revised March 1997 Operation Permit Application - Attachment 2, Section 5 (Operations Plan with revisions), and Attachment 10 with revised drawings. Amended April 28, 1999

8. **Operating Personnel.** As required by F.A.C. 62-701.320(14) and 62-701.500(1), at least one trained operator shall be at the landfill at all times when the landfill receives waste and at least one spotter shall be at the working face. The permittee shall notify the Department in writing of a change of the primary on-site supervisor within 7 days of the effective start date of this new responsible individual. Copies of the training certificates for the newly assigned individual shall also be submitted.

9. **Operation Plan and Operating Record.** The landfill shall have an operational plan which meets the requirements of F.A.C. 62-701.500(2). A copy of the Department approved permit, operational plan, construction reports and record drawings, and supporting information shall be kept at the facility at all times for reference and inspections. An operating record as required by F.A.C. 62-701.500(3) is part of the operations plan, and shall also be maintained at the site.
