This will provide notice to the Department of Lee County's plans to initiate yard waste processing operations at the site of the Lee County Resource Recovery Facility on August 25, 2003. In accordance 62-709.320(1)(c) of the Florida Administrative Code, registration of the yard waste processing operation is not required because the site is authorized under the Conditions of Certification issued for the Resource Recovery Facility, PA 90-30, which remains valid. Department correspondence dated August 10, 2000, which is attached for reference, approved the construction of the Yard Waste Processing Facility.

Lee County Solid Waste has contracted with Lace Construction, Inc., d/b/a D. J. Casey Enterprises to operate the Yard Waste Processing and Recycling Facility. D. J. Casey will provide the equipment and labor to properly process and remove horticultural material from the site.

Dear Mr. Dee:

The Department has received and reviewed your letter dated August 9, 2000, concerning Lee County's request to modify the Conditions of Certification (COC) for the Lee County Resource Recovery Facility. As noted in your letter, the Department has not received any objections to Lee County's plan to build a ... Materials Recovery Facility and a Yard Waste Processing Facility on the certified site for the Resource Recovery Facility. also note that all of the parties involved in the site certification hearing were provided copies of the County's proposal to build a MRF and Yard Waste Processing Facility. Neither the Department nor any of the agencies or other parties have proposed any new or modified conditions of certification to address these two new facilities. Thus, it appears that the conditions of certification for the Lee County Resource Recovery Facility do not need to be modified for the construction of the MRF and Yard Waste Processing Facility.

Based on the Department's review, it appears that the MRF and Yard Waste Processing Facility can be treated as amendments to the County's application for site certification, pursuant to DEP Rule 62-17.205(1)(d), F.A.C. For this reason, the Department has no objection to the County going forward with the construction of the Materials Recovery Facility and Yard Waste Processing Facility.

The Department's conclusions about these issue are subject to several important qualifications. First, the Department assumes that the facts stated in your letter are accurate and correct. If they are not, the Department may need to reconsider and revise its decision. Second, Lee County must comply with
