If a closing should have to occur at the Florida Tire Terminal facility in Avon Park, FL, the following costs would apply. Florida Tire Terminal has a letter from Greenman Technologies (attached) stating the cost to load and remove all tires is \$110.00/ ton.

The actual waste tire quantities on hand and the weights associated with each category are the results of an inventory taken on 1-18-2013 in cooperation with Polston Engineering. These figures indicate the maximum capacities of the various tire storage cells that are indicated on the Facility Plan.

<u>Passenger and Light Truck Tires</u>- 2,364 units at 30 lbs/unit = 70,920 lbs which is equivalent to 35.5 tons.

<u>Truck Tires-</u> 1907 units at 120 lbs/unit = 228,840 lbs which is equivalent to 114.4 tons.

<u>Large Truck Tires-</u> 1180 units at 150 lbs/unit = 177,000 lbs which is equivalent to 88.5 tons.

The total of waste tires equals 238.4 tons. The following calculation applies.

238.4 tons of waste tires x \$110.00 = \$26,224.00

The 238.4 tons represents 7815 total units, which is well below the maximum of FLO 15,000 maximum units that are agreed to in the alternative procedures plan but maximum capacities will vary by the size of the tires inventoried.

This figure of \$26,224.00 represents the total closing cost using \$110.00 as

the per ton cost to remove the tires.
