Liberty Tire Recycling, LLC Site Assessment Report

- Responses to Comments 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, and 8 are satisfactory.
- Response to Comment 3: The Department requested that Liberty Tire conduct a well survey to meet the requirements of 62.780.600 F.A.C. This request concerned a survey of wells interior to the property and stated that it could be included in the RAP. The RAP contained a survey of wells exterior to the facility but not interior. It did not provide an explanation for not including this information. However, since the re-sampling results demonstrated that groundwater was not contaminated, this is no longer necessary.

Limited Scope Remedial Action Plan

• Since Liberty Tire plans on excavating soils to the commercial/industrial soil cleanup target level, it must place an institutional control on the entire property.
