The Department of Environmental Protection gives Notice of its Intent to modify a solid waste operation permit to Lois Rose, Sarasota County Solid Waste Operations Manager. The project will include an update to the facility's Operation Plan for the connection of a Landfill Gas Recovery Facility to the existing landfill gas collection system, and discharge of collected condensate into the existing landfill leachate collection system. The Landfill Gas Recovery Facility will convert landfill gas to energy. This proposed project will be located at Sarasota County Central County Solid Waste Disposal Complex, 4000 Knights Trail Road, in Nokomis. The Department has assigned File Number 0130542-023-SO/IM to this project.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the above proposed agency action may petition for an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel, Marjory Stoneman Douglas Building, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within 14 days of publication of this notice or receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes, or to intervene in this proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;

(b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;

(c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner or a statement that there are no disputed facts;

(e) A statement of facts which the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;

(f) A statement of which rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
