Dear Mr. Buttrey:

In response to the request submitted January 9, 2002, from Ed Chesney, P.E., Permit Nos. SC48-0165969-001 and SO48-0165969-002 are modified to establish the base grade elevation (lowest bottom elevation) of 66' NGVD on the west half of the landfill footprint, to conform with Orange County approval.

The information submitted January 7 and 9, 2002, on file at the Central District office, is made a part of the permits.

All other conditions of the subject permits remain unchanged, including Specific Condition 45, which states in part; "Proof that the financial mechanisms are established and funded in accordance with Rule 62-701-630, F.A.C. and 40 CFR Part 264 Subpart H as adopted by reference in Rule 62-701.630, F.A.C. shall be submitted to the Department sixty (60) days prior to the acceptance of any solid waste at the facility."

This letter must be attached to Permit Nos. SC48-0165969-001 and SO48-0165969-002 and becomes part of these permits.

This correspondence is to serve as a request for a letter modification to the above referenced permit. As a specific condition from Orange County EPD, we are required to modify our FDEP Solid Waste Permit as not to conflict with our Orange County Solid Waste Permit. As it pertains to our FDEP permit, the difference is related to the base grade elevation (lowest bottom elevation) on the west half of the landfill footprint. Currently, our FDEP permits allow us to begin landfill operations at elevation 61' NGVD. The lowest base grade elevation approved by Orange County is 66' NGVD. Attached as Exhibit A is a revised Sheet 5 of 11 which contain the details of the of the revised base grades within each cell. Please review the minor changes to the bottom elevations and if agreeable, replace your record drawings with this revised Sheet 5 of 11.

In addition to a raised base grade elevation, we are required by Orange County EPD to adhere to their "Confinement Restoration Criteria". This criteria was developed by EPD for sites which fail to meet "County criteria" for a bottom liner exemption. As a result, two areas identified within the landfill footprint as unconfined will be restored using on site clays. While restoration of these areas is not a requirement or condition of our FDEP permit, it is required by Orange County EPD.

While a change in base grade elevations such as this would typically be shown on As-Built surveys, we request the change/modification become part of our FDEP record drawings at this time. Additionally for your file, we are acknowledging our intent to comply with the County's Confinement Restoration Criteria within the landfill footprint.

Dear Cecelia:

Since our last exchange of letters, I have learned the Orange County Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has not issued the Solid Waste Management permit for the above-mentioned project. The County has not issued the permit because your client, Buttrey Development Two, LLC (BDT), has not satisfied the terms of the Orange County Board of County Commissioners' approval of the BDT landfill application. Specifically, BDT has not satisfied Conditions of Approval 3, 4, 6, and 11. For your information, I am enclosing a letter dated October 12, 2001, from Jim McDonald, P.E., to Ed Chesney, P.E. The enclosed letter indicates the conditions BDT must complete prior to permit issuance. The transfer of ownership will be scheduled for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners after BDT has fulfilled its obligations and EPD has issued the permit.

Upon reviewing the Specific Conditions of Approval, I also noted that Specific Condition 1 requires the permit applicant to obtain a formal modification of Florida Department of Environmental Protection permits numbered SC48-0165969-001 and SO48-0165969-002 prior to initiating construction and operation of the landfill. If your client has received the required modifications, please forward copies of the modified permits to Jim McDonald and me.

The Orange County Board of County Commissioners voted to issue the above referenced permit on October 2, 2001, subject to twenty-one conditions.

Permit Specific Condition No. 21 was added as a result of the Board action during the October 2, 2001 Public Hearing. Condition No. 21 requires the applicant to pay for the costs associated with the service connection for the McQueen Road residents if and when either Orange County of the City of Apopka extends a water line main to the area.

The following conditions require action on the applicant's part after the Board's affirmative vote and prior to permit issuance. Please respond to the permit conditions below at your earliest convenience so that your permit may be issued.

- 3. Please provide proof that the Financial Assurance in the amount of \$17,089,784.12 is in force.
- 4. Please provide proof that the Title Commitment Insurance for the Boundary Survey is in force.
- 6. Please provide proof that the Title for the Property covered by the permit is held by the applicant, Buttrey Development Two, LLC.
- 6. Please Provide proof that the Notice of Prior Use as a Landfill form has been executed and recorded in the name of the applicant, Buttrey Development Two, LLC.
- 11. Please provide a cashiers check in the amount of \$79,431.00, made payable to the Board of County Commissioners.

Please forward the above items to my attention at the letterhead address for review. Upon acceptance, the permit will be issued.
