

INTENT TO ISSUE
PERMIT FOR MODIFIED
PROJECT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue a permit modification to Woste Management, Inc. of Fiorida/Charles J. Campagna, 255 W. Keene Rd., Apopka, FL 32703, to modify the existing Class III landfill permit to incorporate the expansion of the Class III landfill from 110 acres to 150 acres. The landfill is located at 230 West Keene Rd., Apopka, FL, in Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 28 East, in Orange County, FL.

The Department has assigned File Nos. SC48-0165969-008 and SO48-0165969-009 to the project and Intends to Issue the permit as a modification to the existing Permit No. SC48-0165969-007 for the landfill which expires on January 22, 2006.

The Department will Issue the permit modification unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under sections 120.559 and 120.579 of the Florida Statutes before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Fiorida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received by the cierk) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mall Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within tourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first.

Under section 120.60(3) of the Fiorida Statutes, howev-er, any person who has asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within four-teen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication.

The failure of any person to file a perintener within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Fiorida Statutes. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-106.205 of the Fiorida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner: the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner: the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any; the Department permit identification number and the county in which the subject matter or activity is located; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department action; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. It there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department action; (f) A concise statement of

(f) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief; and
(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by rule 28-106.301.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filling of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a parry to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation under section 120.573 of the Florida Stat-utes is not available for this proceeding.

The application is available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at the Department of Environmental Protection, 3319 Maguire Bivd., Suite 232, Orlande, Fl. 32803, telephone 407/893-3328.
