



SUBJECT: Request for Additional Information – Application No. SO48-0173968-003

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Page 1 of the Operations Plan for the subject facility, under the heading "1.2 Process Review," refers to Class I waste being "processed" before being removed for disposal at a Class I landfill.

To clarify this statement, I spoke to James Golden by telephone on February 3, 2005. Mr. Golden stated that recyclable materials would be removed for recycling only from loads of solid waste from specific sources that would contain source-separated materials. Products to be recycled include clean wood, cardboard, paper, and aluminum. The removed materials are estimated to comprise no more than 5% of the total of waste received.

Based upon this response and review by staff, I consider the application noted above to be complete.

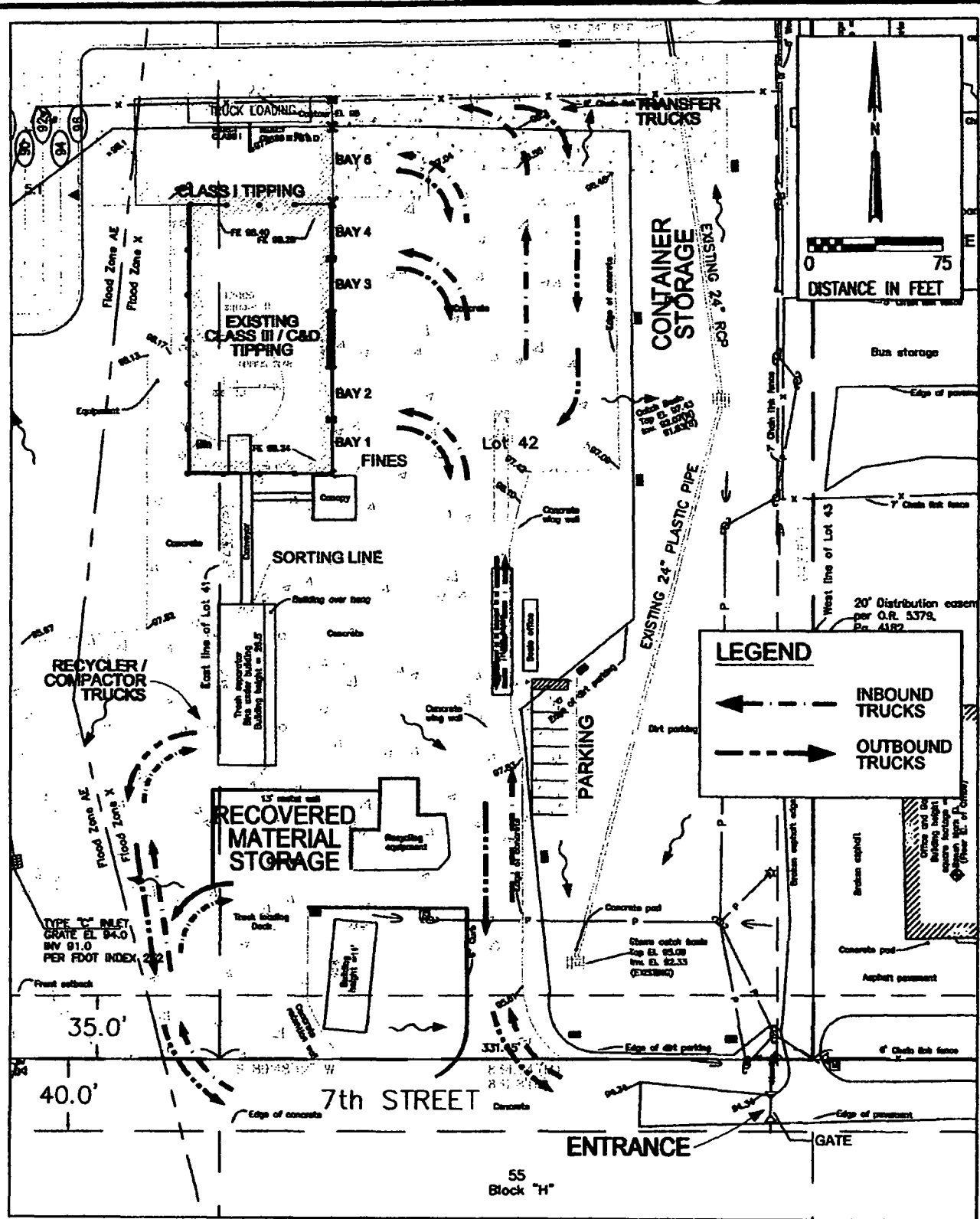

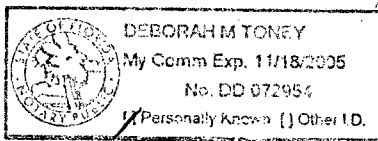

NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
ISSUE PERMIT FOR  
MODIFIED PROJECT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue a permit modification to Taff Recycling, Inc./Bill Condon, 148 Baywood Ave., Longwood, FL 32750. The proposed work involves a modification to the existing operation permit to add processing and transfer areas for Class 1 municipal solid waste (MSW). The facility is located at 375 - 7th St., Taff, in Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, in Orange County, FL.

The Department has assigned File No. SD48-0173968-004 to the project and intends to issue the permit as a modification to the existing operation permit No. SD48-0173968-002 which expires on December 18, 2005.

The Department will issue the permit modification unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below, and must be filed (received by the clerk) in the Office of

General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first.

Under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes, however, any person who has asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication.

The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-106.205 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

- The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any; the Department permit identification number and the county in which the subject matter or activity is located;
- A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department action;
- A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department action;
- A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department action;
- A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief; and
- A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by rule 28-106.301.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position

taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation under section 120.573 of the Florida Statutes is not available for this proceeding.

The application is available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at the Department of Environmental Protection, 3319 Maguire Boulevard, Suite 232, Orlando, FL 32803; telephone (407) 894-7555.
