SUBJECT: Request for Additional Information – Application No. SO48-0173968-003

Page 1 of the Operations Plan for the subject facility, under the heading "1.2 Process Review," refers to Class I waste being "processed" before being removed for disposal at a Class I landfill.

To clarify this statement, I spoke to James Golden by telephone on February 3, 2005. Mr. Golden stated that recyclable materials would be removed for recycling only from loads of solid waste from specific sources that would contain source-separated materials. Products to be recycled include clean wood, cardboard, paper, and aluminum. The removed materials are estimated to comprise no more than 5% of the total of waste received.

Based upon this response and review by staff, I consider the application noted above to be complete.



The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to issue a permit modification to Taft Recycling, Inc./Bill Condron, 148 Baywood Ave., Longwood, FL 32750. The proposed work involves a modification to the existing operation permit to add processing and transfer areas for Class. I municipal solid waste (MSW). The facility is located at 375 - 7th St., Taft, in Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, in Orange County, FL. The Department of Environ-

The Department has assigned File No. \$048-0173968-004 to the project and intends to issue the permit as a modification to the existing operation permit No. \$048-0173968-002 which expires on December 18, 2005.

The Department will issue the permit modification unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filled under sections 120:569 and 120:57 of the Florida Statutes before the deadline for filling a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below:

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for on-administrative proceeding (hearing) under sections 120.589 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below, and must be filed (received by the clerk) in the Office of

General Counsel of the De-partment at 3900 Common-wealth Boulevard, Mail Sta-tion 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first.

Under section 120.60(3) of the Florida Statutes, howev-er, any person who has asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within four-teen days of receipt of such notice; regardless, of the date of publication.
